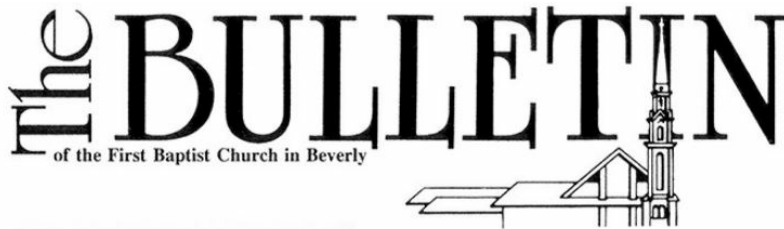

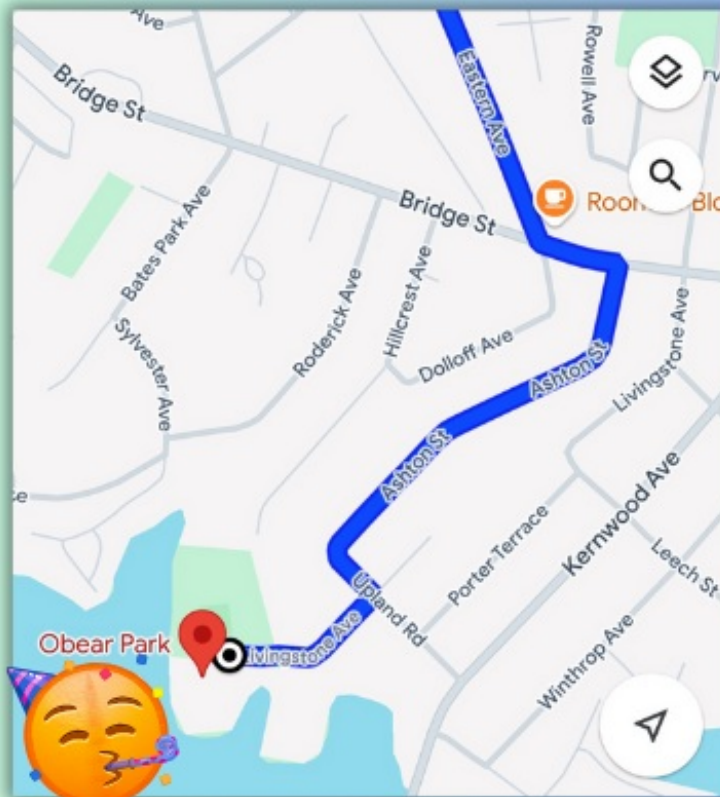

## Turn-By-Turn Directions as if coming from FBC:



Turn right onto Cabot St

0.3 miles



Turn left onto Elliott St

1 mile



Turn left onto Northern Ave

350 feet



Turn left onto Eastern Ave

0.3 miles



Turn left onto Bridge St

300 feet



Turn right onto Ashton St

0.4 miles



Turn right onto Livingstone Ave

0.1 miles

## Let's Restock the Blood Bank in Bob's Honor!

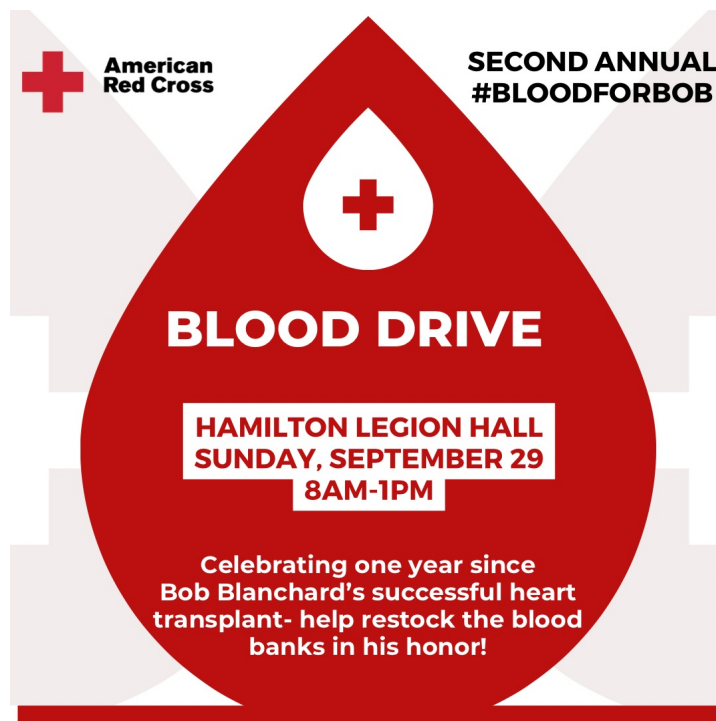
Locally, we have a chance to help restock the blood banks to celebrate **one year** since Bob Blanchard's successful heart transplant!
