


Notes for Sunday:

An Invitation to Take on a Visio Divina Practice During Lent

As part of our stepping into the Lenten journey together this past Sunday, a new image – that of a piece of street art entitled "Girl with Blue Bird" by the anonymous artist Banksy – appeared on the wall of the sanctuary. Our Lenten theme this year – The Art of Rest, Renewal, and Resolve – will find us walking through the season by putting scriptures that tell us of moments in Jesus' life and ministry into conversation with murals and street art found out in communal spaces all around our world. As we move through this season, we will consider what the artwork and the scriptures have to teach us, to offer us, about ways in which we can practice the arts of resting, being renewed, and returning to the good work to which God calls us with renewed

resolve in our own lives.

The images of pieces of street art and murals that will be added to our sanctuary wall week by week also offer another invitation to us: the invitation to take on a new spiritual practice for Lent. *Visio Divina*, or sacred seeing, is a reflective and prayerful way of engaging with an image or piece of art, to reflect on it fully, and to discover, in so doing, what message or meaning it stirs in us, what connection to God's Spirit or our faith we find in what we notice in or about the image.

There are instructions on the mural wall for how to engage in a practice of *Visio Divina* with these images – and there will be blank space on the bottom of each mural where you are

invited to write some of those words, thoughts, or phrases that are evoked for you when you are considering the image. This can be done, of course, on Sunday mornings, at any point before, during, or after the worship service – but the murals and the opportunity for engaging in this practice are also available to folks any time the church is open during the week. The church is typically open from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. on weekdays, with evening hours from 5 or 6 p.m. until 7 or 8 p.m. on weeknights. If you are thinking of coming by at a time you are not certain the church will be open, you can contact the church office (978-922-3295 or by emailing *phaight@fbcbeverly.org*) to check its schedule for that day.

Consider this your invitation to engage in this prayerful practice and this new way of exploring art found in communities all around this Lent!




Coming Home Education Continues






