Music Sunday! May 21



#### Missions in May Campaign: Giving back thru ABC/USA Annual Offerings

For the last three years (2020, 2021 and 2022), the Mission Committee has decided to use a portion of our annual giving funds to contribute to *ABC/USA Annual Offerings* (American Baptist Churches USA), on behalf of our congregation. During the month of May, we will once again be asking for FBC community contributions. Each Sunday, we will highlight one of the four offerings: America for Christ, One Great Hour of Sharing, World Mission Offering, Retired Missionary and Ministers.

Tracing its history to George and Hannah Liele, formerly enslaved people who founded a church in Jamaica in 1783, followed by Adoniram and Ann Judson working in Burma (Myanmar), the American Baptist Foreign Mission Society was formally organized in 1814. It was the first such organization in the United States. Today called *International Ministries*, IM funds diverse programs to help people all over the world through the *World Mission Offering* (WMO). A small sampling of the WMO work includes rebuilding a church in the Dominican Republic destroyed by fire, working with migrants in Mexico, economic development training for ministers in South Asia, providing scholarships to Black clergy, and promoting literacy in Africa. Diversity in mission work is matched by the diversity of the people who work for IM. Two centuries ago, Adoniram Judson wrote, "Our future is as bright as the promises of God." We hope you'll consider a donation to this remarkable organization who respond to God's call as Jesus taught and as the Holy Spirit leads. You are welcome to view these videos to see a moving first-hand look into how God is at work in *Bolivia/Mexico* and *Democratic Republic of the Congo* through your donation.
