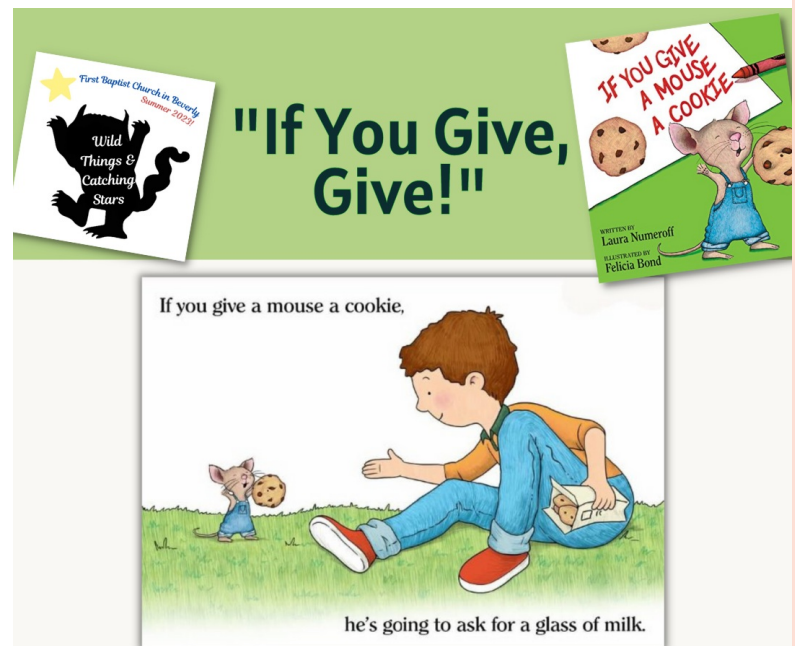


Worship With Us!

Join us in reading and discussing *Rest is Resistance*, by Tricia Hersey.



Feature Spotlight: Emily Feldman, FBC Beverly's Infant & Toddler Room Coordinator

As our summer feature series continues onward, we excitedly present Emily Feldman in her new(er) role as the Infant & Toddler Room Coordinator!

You may recognize Emily as she grew up in Beverly and has been at FBC since 2011 as a Senior High Youth Fellowship-er starting at the end of her Junior year in high school. Emily remained involved with FBC fellowship through graduation and loved the program and people so much, that she ended up traveling with them during the summer of 2012 to South Dakota and has since also traveled with FBC to North Carolina twice and Nicaragua. With a goal of staying involved in hopes of one day becoming a youth advisor herself, Emily became the childcare coordinator in September of 2012 which she maintained for 2+ years as she pursued her medical career (which began requiring weekend work) and then passed the baton to Faith Millar, who did a fabulous job in that room before handing off to our amazing Abby. Emily joined as a Middle School youth advisor in 2013 and became a Middle School AND Senior High Advisor in 2017, later transitioning to volunteer primarily with the Senior High group.



After all of those enriching experiences with some of the older youth at FBC, Emily recently came full circle as she's always loved this the younger age group, and as a former daycare teacher for 5 years, missed working with these little ones. When she caught wind of the need for childcare for our youngest friends at FBC, she knew she'd love to help!

Emily finds it fascinating to watch these youngest learners explore the world around them and seeing their smiles or hearing those little laughs brings her great joy.

When asked how we can support Emily in her position at FBC, Emily mentions always being on the lookout for Middle School through High School-aged helpers for her infants and toddlers. She's also looking for at least one other adult volunteer to help lead the room on Sundays when she's at the hospital working her rotation as a critical care nurse.



Yes, that's right! Not only is Emily caring and compassionate with our littlest FBC Friends, she also works as a Critical Care Nurse at a local hospital located just outside of Boston. When she's not helping others, she enjoys hiking, going to the beach, reading, crocheting and enjoying family time with her husband and two cats. Emily's excited to have recently just closed on her first home with her husband, and they've been spending a lot of their summer updating and renovating with some DIY projects but plan to take a break and go to a concert here in the next few weeks!

When asked about her role this coming year, Emily replies **"I am most looking forward to getting to know the children and families better and to continue providing a welcoming space for our littlest members of FBC!"** Emily also offers that **"FBC is a really special place because it offers a space for people of ALL ages to come together and really feel like they belong."**
