


Join us this Sunday, July 30th at 10:00 am for Worship either in person or via our *FBC YouTube Channel*.




Get To Know Your Neighbor: Rabbi Alison Adler of Temple B'nai Abraham

This week's spotlight on Rabbi Alison Adler is born of a relationship between FBC Beverly and Temple B'nai Abraham that has long predated her thirteen-year tenure at the temple. We excitedly welcome this local Beverly resident and faith partner as we continue to build on our strong, long-standing partnership! If you haven't visited Temple B'nai Abraham before, it's located near Dane Street Beach only about a mile or so down the road from FBC.

Rabbi Alison Adler seeks to help people of all ages find their own spiritual path while being part of a vibrant, caring community. "Interfaith conversations and study are so important," and her Temple shares the values of the First Baptist Church in Beverly. 
