
Worship With Us!

Why?



FBC's Supremely *FUN* Annual Youth Fellowship Kick-Off at Chebacco Lake: Sunday, September 17th, 11:30 am-4:30 pm

J ohn and Eileen Hadley have been serving up 40 meals twice a week for the last seven years out of the First Baptist Church in Beverly. About 30 of those meals are served in house at FBC and 10 packaged "to go" for those who rely on the programs. The Hadleys took over the Monday Night Supper and Saturday Lunch Programs back in 2016 because they believe no one should go hungry. Their motto is "We would not serve anything that we did not feel was food enough to feed our own family, and that is the truth."

In Beverly, did you know there is a free meal available for folks seven days per week? The only downside is that all meals are served in the evening, with the exception of the Saturday lunch at FBC. As our patrons in the community get a meal Friday night, Saturday at Noon, and then not again till Sunday evening, FBC was motivated to change the lunch model. In the past, Saturday lunch consisted of a bowl of soup, a ham or bologna sandwich, some chips, and a cookie. "We felt a heartier meal with more protein would be a healthier option and sustain our guests longer," said the Hadleys.


"The benefits of stewardship are many. The biggest one to us is getting to meet so many new people. We have had multiple volunteers in our time working the kitchen and they have all been great."

So they reached out to supermarkets and restaurants to see if they could possibly get some donations to help beef up their options. Depot Diner in Beverly generously donates the soup now every week, which the guests love. Shaw's in Ipswich has also been extremely generous in providing protein (hamburger, chicken etc.) which greatly reduces the cost of the meal. Rick at Calvary Christian Church occasionally supplies the Saturday Lunch Program with various items for the meal like salad fixings, fruit, etc.

How fortunate to have forged these relationships thanks to such dedicated volunteers collecting and pursuing free food locally from organizations like Green Beverly to provide for those who really need it!

John and Eileen will be passing the torch after their dedicated service this September, so if you are passionate about feeding people and feel called to help, please *email Brenda D*. of the Missions Committee to get involved!
