

# Worship With Us!


Join us this **Sunday, September 3rd at 10:00 am** for Worship either in person or via our *FBC YouTube Channel*.

# Get To Know Your Neighbor: Marty Lincoln, the one and only!





Those who donate flowers for a given Sunday can then take them home after the worship service or choose to gift them to someone else through the helping hands of people like Marty, who will deliver them through the Lay Visitation Team's visits, to Harborlight Homes residents, or to someone who could really use a bouquet to brighten their day!

In addition to her work on the Flower Committee, Marty really enjoys Lay Visitation, probably the largest committee she is on, but she's newly became a Deacon for the first time in 50 years! She also organizes the Rummage Sale (which she's been doing for about twenty or so years) and is in charge of the homemade wares church table at the Holiday Fair. Marty really enjoys the Prayer Shawl group, too, and helps work on (you guessed it!), prayer shawls, prayer squares, blankets for Seniors going to college, as well as baby blankets. She's also on the volunteer list for the FBC meals program and often helps serve lunches at the church, too.

So how did Marty get her start at FBC?! It was all thanks to a wonderful friend from the hospital with whom she worked who brought her to church. Marty thought it was going to be very different, but told her friend, "This was just like what I'm used to." Marty goes on to say "I can't imagine not having FBC for my family." Marty is looking forward to heading to Lake Winni for Labor Day Weekend Family Camp, a group of which she has been a part for the past five years.

When asked what advice she'd give to new FBCers, Marty had this to say! You will feel very much part of a family here" and "The more children at the church, the better!" She goes on "It's very worthwhile, warm and comforting at FBC Beverly, and we'll help you with anything." She notes how much the church not only does to help its congregation, but also the greater Beverly community as well.


