



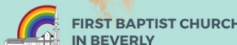

Join Your Church Friends for a Craft Night on Saturday, October 14th at 7:00 p.m.!

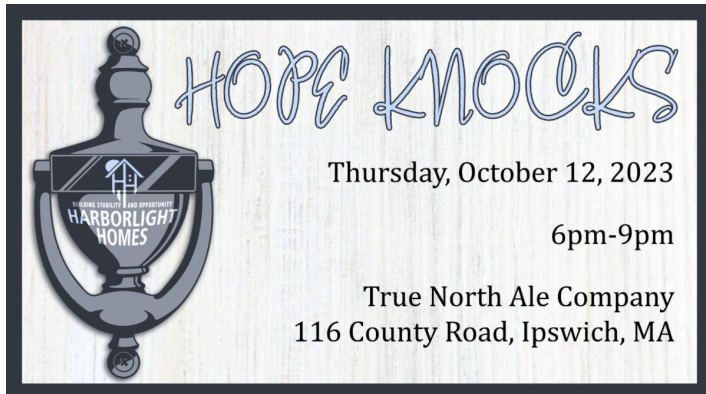
