

Harborlight Homes celebrates the completion of Granite Street Crossing, the organization's first multigenerational community at 5 Granite Street in Rockport. The property consists of 17 affordable studio apartments for people 62+ in one building with multiple community common spaces and 6 affordable townhouses for families. The property includes a playground and is walkable to the train, beach and downtown.
