




Your Electronic Version of the Summer Bucket List, as Promised!

Esther is out of the office attending the American Guild of Organists conference from July 1st through July 5th.


Daniel is on vacation July 2nd-14th. He will be back in the office on July 15th. Julie will be available during this time for any pastoral needs or emergencies.
