

This Friday night is our FINAL PNO of the church program year & school year, and we're HAVING A PARTY!





Property tours of the existing Anchor Point residence will be offered at 12:30 p.m. following the groundbreaking.

TLC will serve as a brick and mortar manifestation of the service-enriched housing offered by Harborlight Homes. It will be built and furnished entirely by donations; the public campaign is now open, with the potential for naming rights or to purchase a paver to support this mission. First Baptist Church is a major, early supporter of the philanthropy that allowed the building to be constructed. Church member Tracey Armstrong, who led the successful first phase of the capital campaign, will be speaking.






