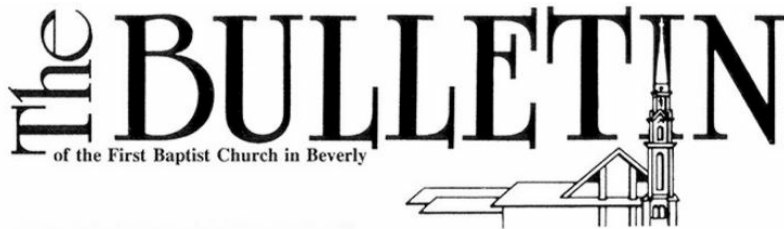

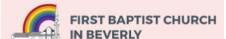

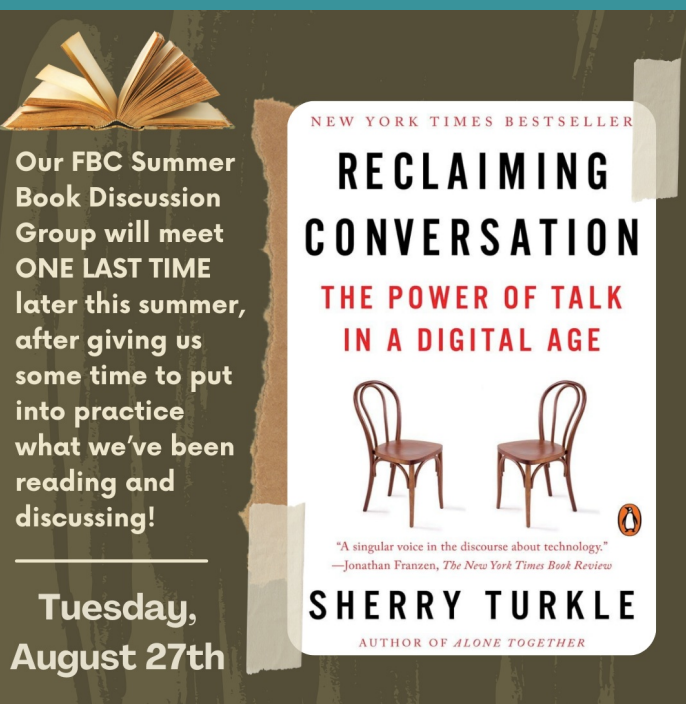
A Walk in the Woods this Friday, August 9th at 5:30 p.m.
