

# Introducing First Baptist's Incoming Student Ministers!

### Warmest Welcome!

At the last Church Council meeting of 2024, the Council unanimously supported a proposal from the ministerial staff to introduce a Student Ministry Internship program at First Baptist Beverly. FBC Beverly has historically been a place of learning, growth, and development for students pursuing and exploring a call to ministry, with former student ministers like Rev. Cindy Maybeck, Rev. Scott Cousineau, Rev. Julie Flowers, and Rev. John DeNardo (among others!) going on to ordination and to faithful service of and leadership to and for American Baptist Churches, as well as ABCUSA/UCC Federated churches.

The proposal affirmed by the Church Council at this time would make First Baptist's intention to be a place of teaching and learning for those pursuing a call to ministry more formal, ultimately perhaps leading to the church's becoming an official Field Education site of one or more of the Divinity/Theological Schools in the BTI (Boston Theological Interreligious Consortium). At a time when many churches are experiencing uncertainty about the future and when fewer students are pursuing a call to local church ministry, it feels important that churches like First Baptist Beverly, with much to offer and share, lean into the role of being places of growth, learning, community, and development for those whom God has called to minister.

We are excited, then, to be officially welcoming our first Student Ministers following that Council vote, who will be stepping officially into their roles as Student Ministry Interns for the remainder of this program year!

Please help us officially welcome Kelsey Belis and Jenny Lane into our Student Ministry program! In the coming weeks and months, you will get to interact with both Kelsey and Jenny more regularly in areas and aspects of the ministry and life of First Baptist, as well as see them participate in worship and preach more regularly. Julie and Daniel will serve as their supervisors in these roles and will be working to help nurture, cultivate, and grow the wonderful gifts they already bring to and for ministry – and we will all have the benefit and blessing of learning from them and being moved and enriched by their ministerial gifts, as well.

Here's a bit more about both Kelsey and Jenny, as we embark on this journey together:

**Kelsey Belis (they/them)** has been a member of First Baptist Church in Beverly for 4 years. Originally from the coast of Maine, Kelsey grew up with a strong appreciation for community and connection—values that have shaped their approach to life and ministry.



With a degree in Christian Ministries and Biblical Studies, Kelsey brings both academic knowledge and a heartfelt passion for ministry. In addition to their role at the church, Kelsey serves as the director of a Head Start program at a local nonprofit, where they are dedicated to fostering growth and opportunity for children and families in the community.

Kelsey and their wife, Amber, discovered First Baptist Church in Beverly at a time when they were searching for an affirming and welcoming community. Needless to say, FBC Beverly quickly became a place where they felt at home. Outside of work and ministry, Kelsey enjoys

spending time outdoors, diving into a good book, and exploring local coffee shops.

As Student Minister, Kelsey hopes to inspire young people—and the entire congregation—to discover and share their authentic selves, challenge their existing worldview, and deepen their faith. They are also particularly passionate about creating a safe and affirming space for queer youth in the congregation, ensuring they know they are loved just as they are; a message Kelsey once found themselves needing.



Jenny Lane (she/her) is a current MDiv (Master of Divinity) student at Boston University, where she is focusing her studies on interfaith dialogue and religion, as well as on conflict transformation. For almost two decades, Jenny owned a yoga studio and worked teaching others to become yoga instructors. Her passion in her own spirituality was always rooted in a love of God, and, for Jenny, teaching yoga was a way to mirror God's call to minister to others in love and to offer unconditional love to as many people as possible.

Jenny is mom to Zyan, who will tell you he is 9 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yearsold, but who has an August birthday! They are blending

their family with Ben and Ayla Pertler, who is 8-years-old. Jenny and Ben plan to be married this May.






### DINING OUT AT THE CASTLE!


